

IMREE Installation Guide

All available versions of IMREE are available on IMREE project page at <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>. The web version of IMREE is flash and is available on the library's site at <http://library.sc.edu/IMREE>. The ability to upload files and take pictures from within the IMREE application is blocked in the flash Web version for security reasons. Curators are highly encouraged to use the installable IMREE application for their computer (windows or mac).

During desktop or mobile installation, there will be a security message that states that Adobe AIR cannot verify the authenticity of the program. This message will appear until we install a security certificate for the IMREE program. The security message will never appear on the flash web version.

Windows XP, 7, 8

To Install IMREE:

- Download and open IMREE.exe from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>
- You can change any of the installation options to fit your preferences, or use the default values.

To update IMREE:

- Re-download and open IMREE.exe from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>.
- You will be prompted to replace the current program with a new version.

Mac OS X

To install IMREE:

- Download and Install Adobe AIR from <http://get.adobe.com/air/>
- Download and open IMREE.air from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/> and follow the prompts.

To update IMREE

- Re-download and open IMREE.air from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>.
- You will be prompted to replace the current program with a new version.

Android

To install IMREE:

- Download and open IMREE.apk from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>
- During installation you will be prompted to allow installation of programs from unknown sources.
 - Open Android Settings
 - Select Security
 - Enable "Unknown Sources" option.

To update IMREE:

- Re-download and open IMREE.exe from <http://imree.tcl.sc.edu/>.
